History:

The Reflexology Registration Council of Ontario (RRCO), incorporated with a letters patent in 1998, is the voluntary self-governing body for Reflexologists in the province of Ontario. The founding members include representation from:

- Fairbrass School of Complementary Therapies (FSCT) - Ottawa, Ontario.
- Holt Reflexology School (HRS) - Bolton, Ontario
- International Institute of Reflexology - Canada (IIR) - Oshawa, Ontario
- Ontario College of Reflexology (OCR) - New Liskeard, Ontario
- Reflexology Association of Canada (RAC) - Edmonton, Alberta
- Wholistic Therapies School (WTS) - Palgrave, Ontario

The Council is also represented by elected registered reflexologists, committed to the advancement of Reflexology.

Why Register with the RRCO?

To protect the identity and the right to practise reflexology in the province of Ontario.

Registered Nurses (R.N.), Registered Dietitians (R.D.), Registered Massage Therapists (R.M.T.) and other health professionals each have a registering self-governing body that represents their profession. As a registered member of a profession, the members are recognized within the community as having met the specific criteria of their profession and are recognized by the public for their services.

These professionals meet educational and professional criteria to qualify for registration. Yearly dues are paid to maintain the Professional Ethics of the profession and to the public.
